A "consumer report" may contain information relating to your criminal history, credit history, driver's license information/including motor vehicle violations, drug and alcohol (accident results for DOT requirements), social security verification, verification of education or employment history, or other general background check information.

An "investigative consumer report" (in addition to the information shown above) also may include information regarding your character, general reputation, personal characteristics, and mode of living, whichever are applicable (this may involve personal interviews with sources such as previous employers, co-workers, neighbors, friends, or associates).

You have the right, upon written request made within a reasonable time after receipt of this notice, to request details of the nature and scope of any investigative consumer report made by e-Verifile.
